DRFC Youth Information

Youth rugby is normally safe and injuries are rare. Nevertheless, prevention is better than cure and, for our part, many of our coaches have Rugby Football Union qualifications and have also attended first aid courses. A medical problem or disability does not necessarily preclude a child from playing rugby, but your child's Age Group Manager and coach should be aware of anything to look out for and, if symptoms become apparent, what to do. Also, in the unlikely event of an injury when you are not present, we should be able to authorise emergency treatment. We would also like to remind parents that Dorking RFC is not a crèche facility. It is important that a parent (or nominated adult advised to the coaching team) is present at all times in case of injury and to supervise behaviour of your child/ren during training or in and around the club. The clubhouse is open for hot and cold refreshments. As a precautionary measure, please let us know if your child suffers a serious injury, particularly concussion or a head injury, at home or at school.

TETANUS	We strongly recommend that all players are up-to-date with anti-tetanus injections.										
MOUTH-GUARDS	It is compulsory for players to wear mouth guards during matches and training sessions from the age of U9, and is strongly recommended for all other players. Mouth guards fittings will be scheduled at the beginning of the season. Temporary mouth guards are available from the Club shop along with a full range of DRFC Kit										
RFU REGISTRATION SCHEME	Nationally, the RFU have been operating a registration scheme for all Youth players. Players must register to enable them to participate in matches & tournaments. Forms are available from your Age Group Manager. Please complete this form along this registration form. Photos are not required										
FIRST-AID	Each Age group requires First Aid Cover if you have any particular medical or first aid qualifications and would be prepared to help, please advise your child's age group coach.
