## **DRFC Youth Information**

Youth rugby is normally safe and injuries are rare. Nevertheless, prevention is better than cure and, for our part, many of our coaches have Rugby Football Union qualifications and have also attended first aid courses. A medical problem or disability does not necessarily preclude a child from playing rugby, but your child's Age Group Manager and coach should be aware of anything to look out for and, if symptoms become apparent, what to do. Also, in the unlikely event of an injury when you are not present, we should be able to authorise emergency treatment. We would also like to remind parents that Dorking RFC is not a crèche facility. It is important that a parent (or nominated adult advised to the coaching team) is present at all times in case of injury and to supervise behaviour of your child/ren during training or in and around the club.
